DAY 1: Psalm 119:140

Thy word is very pure: therefore thy servant loveth it.

DAY 3: 2 Timothy 2:15

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

DAY 5: 1 John 2:5

But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.

DAY 7: Psalm 119:127

Therefore I love thy commandments above gold; yea, above fine gold.

DAY 9: Psalm 1:2

But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

DAY 11: Psalm 119:48

My hands also will I lift up unto thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy statutes.

DAY 13: Luke 11:28

But he said, Yea rather, blessed *are* they that hear the word of God, and keep it.
