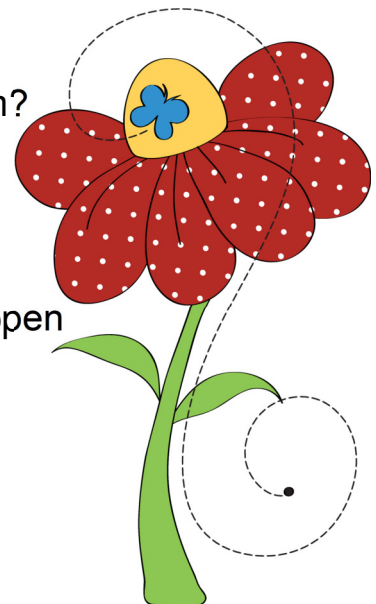


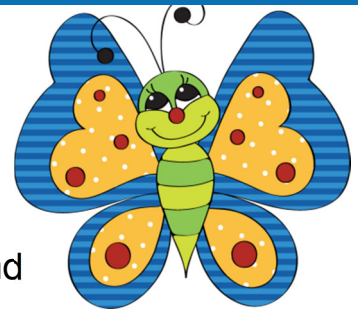
Nebuchadnezzar the King

10. How did Daniel react to the dream?

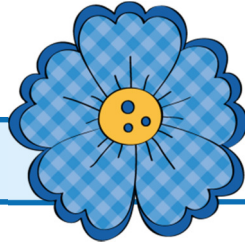
11. What did Daniel say that the tree stood for?

13. What happened to the King when the appointed hour came?

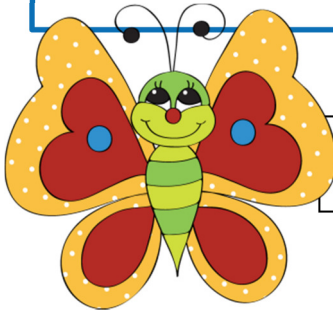
14. When did the King's reason return to him?
