 - Focusing on the traits of friendship.
 - Love.
 - Sharing joys and sorrows.
 - Praying for each other.
 - Encouraging each other.

- Going the extra mile for each other.
- Following the example of Jesus, our True Friend.
- Tell Tale Signs of a Growing Christian
 - Spiritual fruit.
 - Compassion and love for others.
 - Regular Bible reading.
 - Regular prayer time.
 - Suiting up in our Christian armor (Ephesians 6).
 - Many other things!
- Show me a Sign
 - Study the passage in Matthew 16 where the Pharisees and Sadducees wanted a sign from Jesus.
- Signs and Wonders
 - Study the plagues of Egypt and the story of Moses.
 - Study various signs from God throughout the Bible.
 - Study the Christmas signs.
 - Jesus birth foretold. (Isaiah 7:14)
 - The star. (Matthew 2:1-2)

Working with Decals/Peel Off Lettering

- What are we allowing to rub off on us and imprint us?
 - The world or God's Word?
 - Who are our heroes?
 - What do we think is important?

Rubber Stamp Projects

- Being branded for Christ.
- Exhibiting the mark of Christ in our lives by how we act and how we live.

Bead Crafts

- How God colors our world.
- God knows how to fit the pieces together.

Making Cards

- A card shows care and concern and can brighten someone's day.
 - How do we do that?
 - Do we bring joy to people?
 - Do we stir up love?
 - Do we stir up encouragement?

Sewing Projects

- "Eye" of the needle
 - The gift of Salvation.
 - "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God." Matthew 10:25
- Stitched together
 - The body of Christ.
 - We have a bond
 - We have a common cause Christ.
 - We have to work together.
- "A stitch in time saves nine"
 - Making an effort for Christ so we have no regrets.
- "Button your lip"
 - Bring a lesson on the tongue.
- Mend your fences
 - $\circ~$ The need to ask for forgiveness.
 - $\circ~$ The need to put things right with others and with God.
- Mend your ways
 - Study the story of the Prodigal Son. (Luke 15)
 - Don't be a torn garment! Mend your ways!
- In need of mending
 - What's in your life that you see signs of wear in?
 - Are there things falling apart in your life?
 - Turn to the Word of God.
 - Turn to prayer.
 - Turn to fellow Christians.

Knitting Project

- Knit together in love
- Hooked on the Word of God
- Casting on
 - This is a term in knitting that means new stiches. They aren't dependent on the ones you've previously done on a project.
 - Sometimes we need to "cast on" in our Christian life. We need to change it up. We need to start fresh and go forward.
 - Add in some new "stitches" to your Bible reading.
 - Change it up!
 - Do something new!
 - Start a new study of a book you never had done before!
 - Do a different type of study that you have never done before!
 - Add in some new "stitches" to your prayer time.
 - Change where you pray!
 - Change how you pray!
 - Change who you pray for---Add in new people!
 - Change what you pray for---Add in new things!
 - Change what you are thankful for---Find new things to be grateful to the Lord for.
 - Add in some new "stitches" to your worship time with God.
 - Sing some songs of Worship!
 - Pour your heart out in praise like you've never done before!
 - Honor and quote the attributes of God!
 - Honor and quote the names of God!
 - Honor and quote the character traits of God!
 - Get out a pen and paper and write down all the things that God has created!
 - Get a pen and paper and write down why you love the Lord!
