How brave are we in Christ? Do we witness? Do we give all we can and use all our energy to move the cause of Christ along? Talk about those brave Heroes of the Faith (Hebrews 11)

Focus on the slogan "I want you". How we can all be good citizens whether we join the service or do our duty at home just on an every day basis.

Focus on how Christ "wants you".
